Mississippi State University Annual Security Report

According to the Jeannie Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act) and the Department of Education's Title IV disclosure requirements, institutions which participate in Federal student financial aid programs are required to provide information to the public regarding campus safety and security policies and procedures. Statistics regarding crimes related to their campuses must also be reported.

This report includes statistics for the previous three years concerning reported crimes that occurred on campus; in certain off-campus buildings or property owned and controlled by MSU; and on property within, or immediately adjacent to and accessible from, the campus. This report also includes institutional policies concerning campus security, such as alcohol and drug use, crime prevention, the reporting of crimes, sexual assault, and other matters.
